

• Accessible seating for the plenary session is available in the rear section of the auditorium, to the right or left.


Sensory Considerations

Need Help? FAQs

Where can I take a short break?

 The back of the auditorium can serve as a quieter space during the morning. Additional options include space outside (weather permitting), as well as the seating behind the Soldiers & Sailors welcome desk (main lobby).

How do I access the lactation space?
